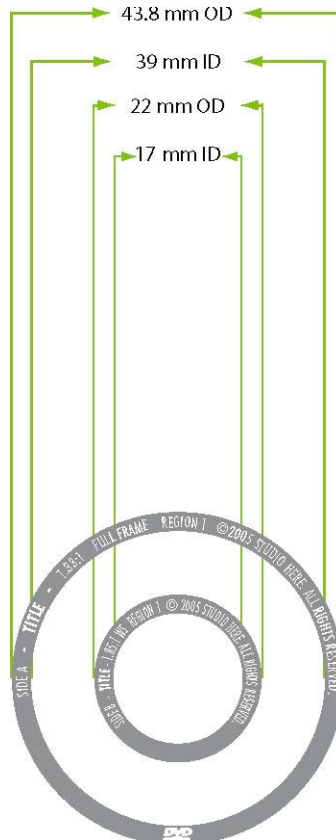


DVD 10/14/18 Label Art Specification Printable Area Shaded in Gray.

Traditionally, DVD 10 labelart printing has been double-sided print.
Technicolor prefers the use of the single-sided print option, rather than the traditional double-sided option.

| <ul style="list-style-type: none"> o Electronic files only for DVD 10/14/18 labelart. o The shaded area of the template above represents the printable area. Do not deviate from the printable area. Modifying the printable area can affect the clamping area in the center-hub and may lead to playability issues. o Minimum font point size: 5.5 pt. San Serif Font (Preferred: Futura Medium Condensed and Futura Bold Condensed) o Use all capital letters. Avoid squeezing too many characters in your design. Abbreviating such text as: FULL FRAME to FF, WIDESCREEN to WS, eliminating ALL RIGHTS RESERVED on the center ring are encouraged and will help maintain text legibility. Do not horizontal scale text below 70%. o Minimum line width: 0.5 pt. o Minimum line width knockout/reversed: 0.75 pt. o Number of allowable colors: Minimum 2, Maximum 3. | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> o Collect for output, all graphic elements (links) and fonts (printer and screen). Include sub-ordinate fonts used in linked graphic elements. o Technicolor will trap your electronic file. o Indicate all colors required. This includes white floods or custom white. Technicolor recommends the use of white under all PMS colors. Without a white base under the PMS color, the desired color(s) may vary due to the metallic reflection. o Specify all knockout elements and their final appearance. This will ensure Technicolor meets your desired finished product. o Color-accurate proofs are not required for DVD 10/14/18 labelart submissions. Technicolor will match the Pantone Solid Coated colors called out with a 1/2 shade. o Do not create a bleed when designing DVD 10/14/18 labelart. |
